If there was a puzzle or activity you especially like from the Spring or Winter packs, let us know! We're planning on creating a Summer version and would love to include your favorites.



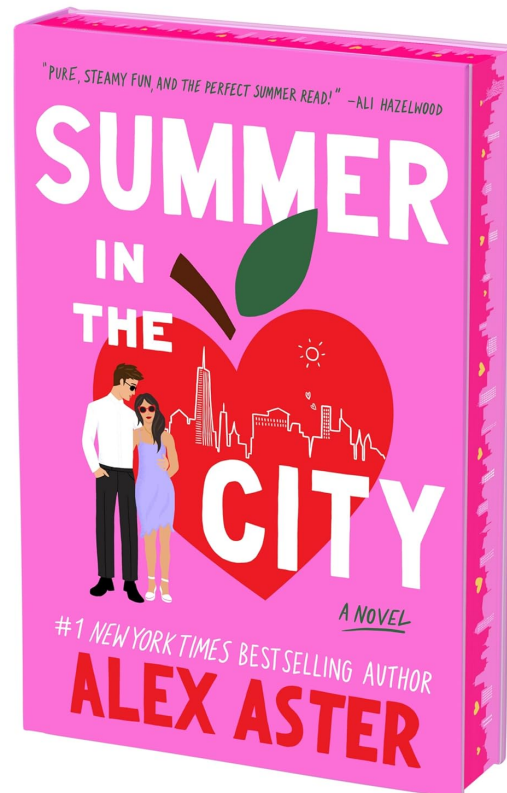
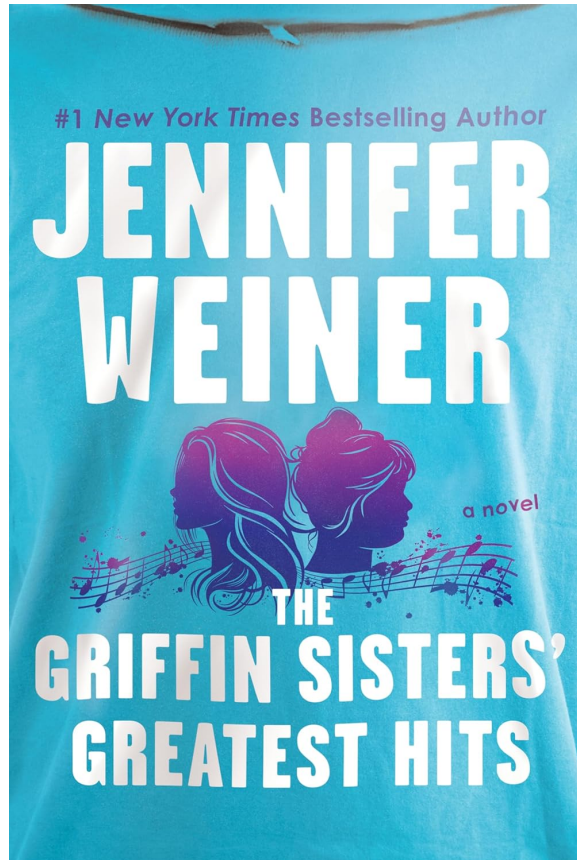
