Our goal is to teach. We want you to feel more confident using your device! Please expect to learn how to do something, not have us do it for you. Additionally, our volunteer will not create passwords or enter personal information for you.

Thankful Chain

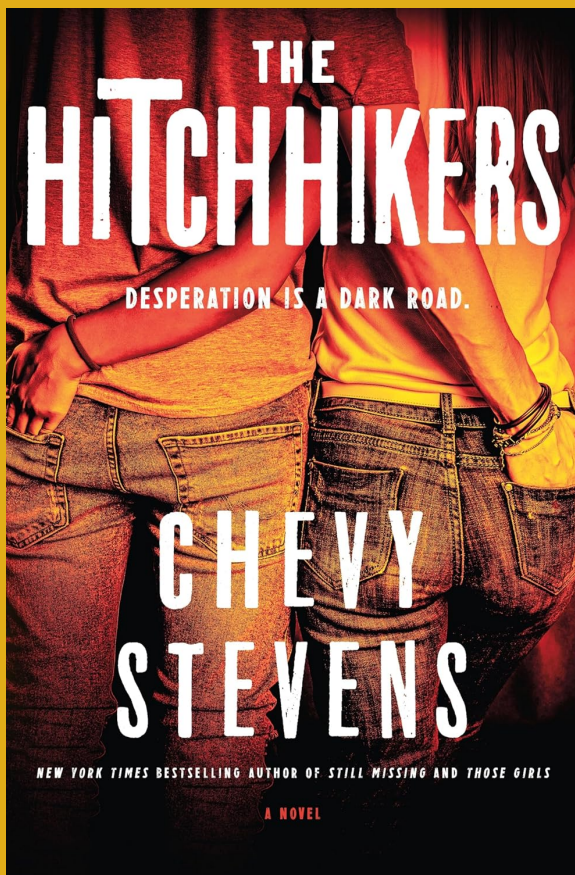
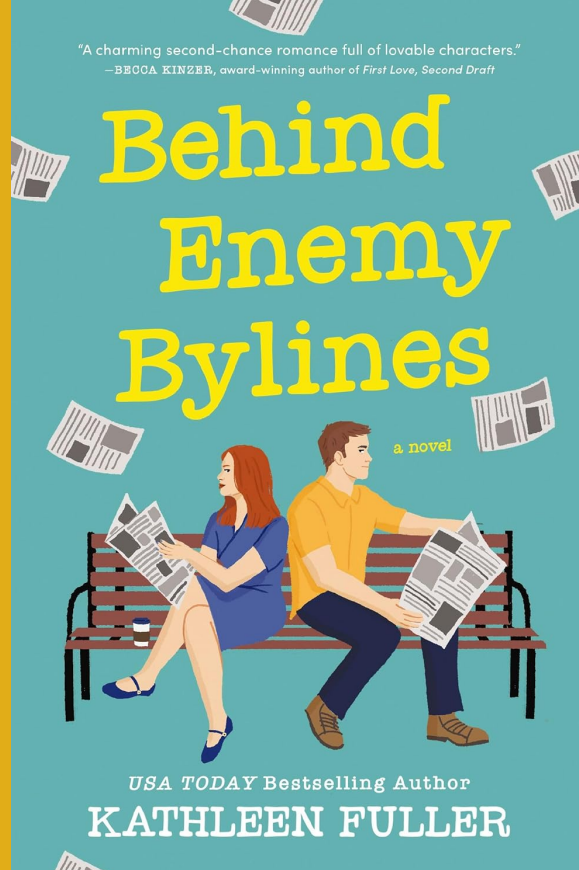
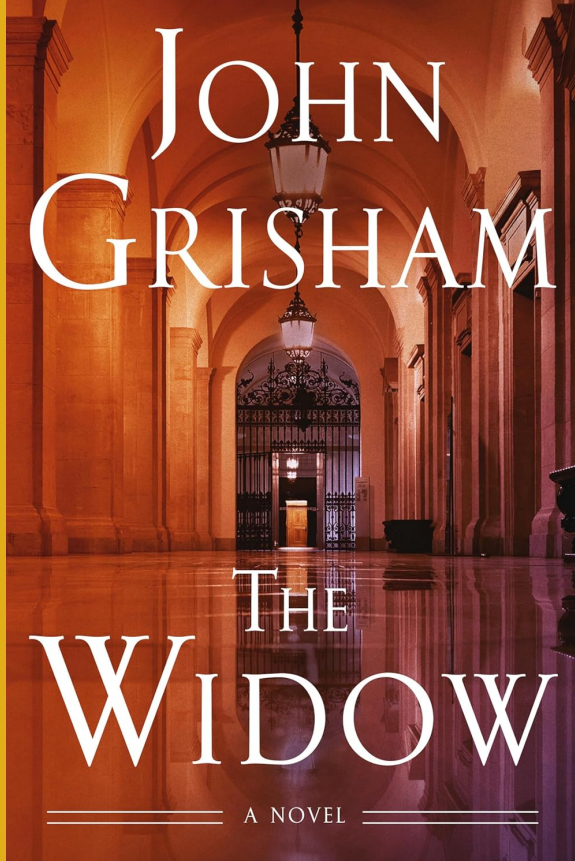
