Moyer Loves Our Local History Section

Moyer loves our local history selection and wants you to love it, too! Come visit! Our array of materials works for researchers and casual browsing. You'll find Ford County History in books, historical atlases, plat books, and more.

For years, local citizen Gail Hutchcraft cut out newspaper obituaries of local residents. We have her collection in alphabetical binders. Leaf through GCHS and GCMS yearbooks. Browse local church and group cookbooks. Dip into historic scrapbooks made by former residents.

Search old newspapers with our microfilm machine. Prefer online? Moyer has a subscription to newspapers.com. Access The Ford

County Blade, The Ford County Chronicle, The Ford County Press, The Gibson City Courier, The Melvin Transcript, Prospect City Press, The Roberts Herald, The Sibley Journal, and The Weekly Standard.

Be sure to view the display cases near the shelves. We use them to highlight materials and collections stored in our Local History Closet. By rotating the displays, we're able to both showcase and preserve the materials. Currently you'll find Gibson City plates and mugs. Visit again later this spring for new displays.

Local history materials may not be borrowed or checked out. This protects fragile and older materials and makes them always available for research. We invited you to Moyer. Spend time here. Much may be discovered at the library.

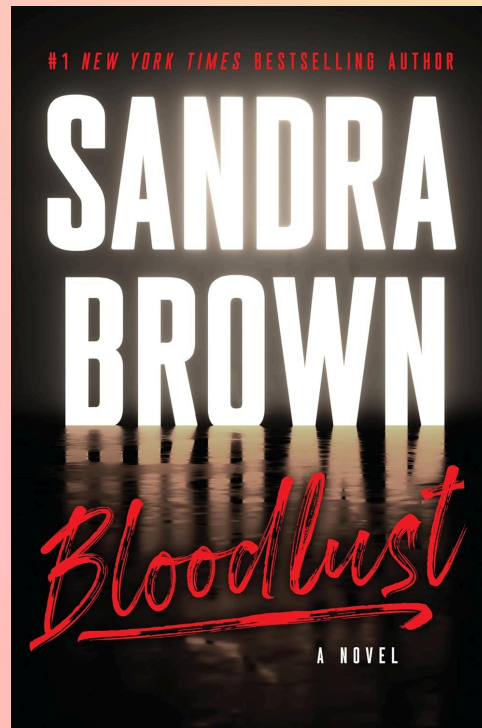
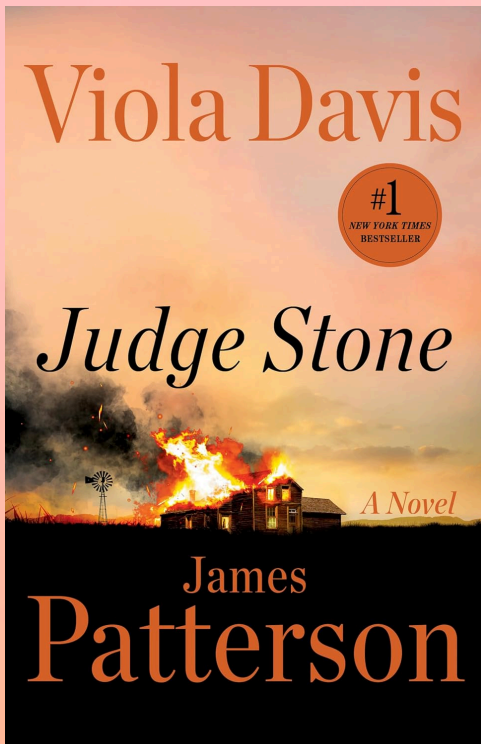
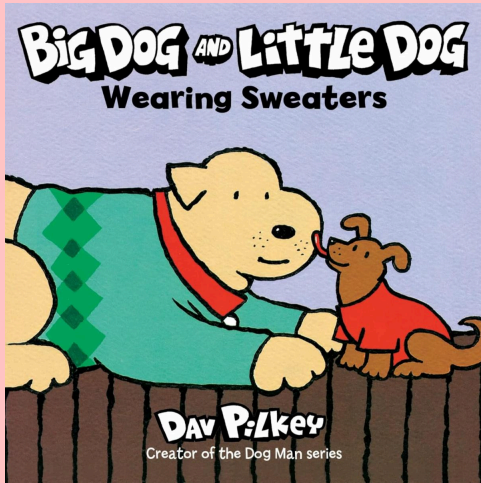
